VIJNANA VIHARA RESIDENTIAL SCHOOL : ANNUAL DAY (11th January, 2026)

46th Annual Day of VijnanaVihara Residential School was celebrated on 11th January, 2026. Dr.D.KalyanChakravarthy, I.R.S., Joint Commissioner, CGST, Bhubaneswar inaugurated the Physical Demonstrations. Sri KondapalliSrinivas Hon. Minister for Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh, Sri KannaBhaskar State Organising Secretary, Vidya Bharathi, Vijayawada were the other guests of honour.

Dare devil feats on motorbikes diving through fire rings, an array of tube lights, girls demonstrating yogasans on ropes hanging from a 75 feet tall crane, marked the physical demonstrations rendered as a part of 46th annual day celebrations. While the event started with musical band followed by muscle stretching physical exercises with dumbbels maintaining agility and rhythm, students demonstrated Ancient Indian wrestling form Mallakhamba, girl students demonstrated yogasans on tall hanging ropes. Passionate of playing with flames students demonstrated human pyramids coordinating in large teams. Rhythmic kolatam and chakkabhajana added a cultural flavour to the show. Earlier, the physical demonstrations were inaugurated by Dr. D. Kalyan Chakravarthy, I.R.S., Joint Commissioner, CGST. Hon. Sri KondapalliSrinivas, Minister for Micro and Medium Enterprises, Govt. of A.P. was the Chief Guest. Students demonstrated their physical might, collaboration and synchrony in the 63 events performance in 57 minutes.
